

but Scott got the biggest cheer, and he deserved it for his pluck, for there was a real scramble just before the tape.

J. Sir, the Hungarian holder of the 100 yards title, was beaten into third place by A. W. Sweeney (Milocaian) and M. B. Osendarp, of Holland, in the slow time of 10 1-5sec.

It was one of the most spectacular sprints seen in the championships.

Osendarp and Sir dashed ahead, but Sweeney strained hard and got up in the last two yards to win by a foot.

Some remarkably fine throwing was seen in the discus event.

The Greek, N. Syllas, led at the end of the first and second rounds with a throw of 153ft. 9in., and H. Andersson, of Sweden, with 152ft. 2in., was next, but Andersson's first throw in the third round cleared 161ft. 2in., which beat the British record.

Andersson, who holds the world record of 171ft. 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ in., later threw the discus 169ft. 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ in.

### Walkers Retire

The heat was terrific for the seven miles walk, which was won by H. A. Hake.

For the first two miles Fletcher, Bullock, Hake and Plumb were together in front of Cooper.

Hake had a ten yards lead of Cooper at three miles in 23min. 12 3-5sec., with Dickinson third.

Hake then took a clear lead from Redman and Pope, Cooper having retired, and at five miles Hake was well away, with only six left on the track.

Most of them complained of the heat, and Redman retired distressed.
