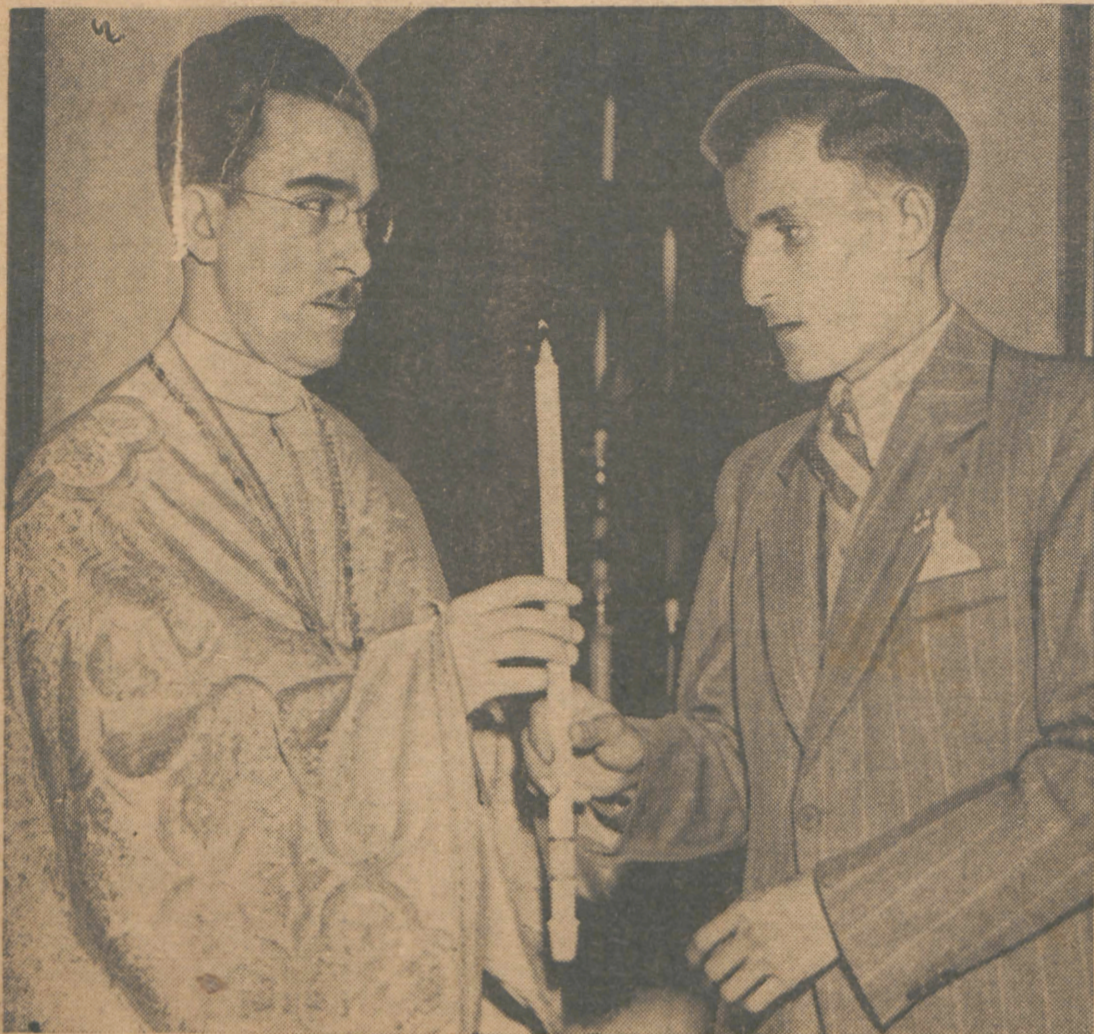


BRAVES WIN IN 11TH, 3 TO 2
