22/5/1962: (Tuesday) (1)

Refs 14-12 were delivered to me by messenger of the Turkish Embassy at my office at 6 pm. I immediately telephoned Mr. G. Cleides, Acting President of the Republic, who was at the House of Representatives, and met him there at 6.15 pm. The Attorney-General was requested to meet us there also. The Acting President authorised the issue of the statement at R. 15 and arranged for C.B.C. to release it after the issue of the Turkish Ambassador's Statement at R. 13-12. He also dictated, signed and sent R. 18-17. He requested to me to see him at the Presidential Palace the next morning to reply to R. 14-12.

23/5/1962: (Wednesday):

I went to the Presidential Palace with a draft reply to R. 14-12. The Acting President approved R. 22-21 and arranged for a messenger to deliver it to the Turkish Ambassador.
