
CBS software

Centraal Bibliotheek System

- Designed for union catalogues
 - Group level; importance of defining data standards, scripts
- Generic
- Evolving
 - GUM project (2000-2002) conversion to UNIX (CBS4)
 - Recently re-engineered
 - UNICODE project (2003-2004)


Robust

- All new versions implemented on Dutch union catalogue first
- Dutch union catalogue and Unity UK – constantly monitored
 - Peak 40 transactions per second
- NLA: only 2 instances of being down in 2 years; never slow



Speed

- av. <0.1 - 0.4 secs
- Index re-build: 2 hours for 12 million records
- Highly tuned batch load
 - 10,000 records per hour (full matching and merging)
 - 30,000 records per hour (identifier matching and merging)
 - 50,000 records per hour (no matching and merging)
- Real time export: 80 records a second







Some good news – the NLA has successfully tested the Thai script in CBS, including full round trip testing from input to output, indexing, searching and export to the Teratext database and are ready to go into production with it. This is the first of many new scripts that they are considering introducing throughout this year. From a national service viewpoint, this is a most significant improvement over the previous service where the main problem was Romanization of Homeric poems in Persian / Arabic script. The NLA has now developed a database for CJK only. Bemal al-Qur'aan delighted me when I told her about this work. I will let you know how high her standards are.







Constantine P. Cavafy, also known as Konstantin or Konstantinos Petrou Kavafis, or Kavaphes (Greek Κωνσταντίνος Π. Καβάφης) (April 29, 1863 – April 29, 1933) was a major Greek poet who worked as a journalist and civil servant. He has been called a skeptic and a neo-pagan. In his poetry he examines critically some aspects of Christianity, patriotism, and homosexuality, though he was not always comfortable with his role as a nonconformist. He published 154 poems; dozens more remained incomplete or in sketch form. His most important poetry was written after his fortieth birthday.



Current and Future Strategy

- Help libraries world wide to provide world class service that are cohesive
 - Flexibility in integration of regional data and services
- Use of WorldCat Grid Services
 - Data access via download and web services
 - E.g. Worldcat API enriched data, mined data, linked data, authority data
 - Software components
- Partner involvement
 - E.g. Job Management
- Identify standards gaps and help develop them
 - Promote existing standards and interoperability

CBS – Heal Context

- Evolution of work done to date: Capabilities
 - load data from the **Advance** system
 - determine **best format** for the union catalogue (MARC21, UNIMARC, other)
 - interoperate with **existing ILS systems** (ADVANCE , Horizon, Aleph, Virtua and AVEKT)
 - interoperate with emerging **open source** systems
 - Interoperate with **content management** systems, **electronic resource** management systems and **repositories**

Virtual Union Catalogue

- Advantages:
 - Light weight organization
 - Relatively easy to implement; easy to get agreements
 - Need metasearch engine and portal
 - Ad-hoc basis: easy to extend – easy to disconnect
- Disadvantages:
 - Slow
 - Limited common searching accesses
 - Limited sorting / relevance
 - Duplicates
 - Searching inefficiencies
 - Varying quality
 - **Availability of all systems**
 - Configuration maintenance



Update protocols compared

- **SRU Update**
- Two **databases** are **not identical** – e.g. A union catalogue is not a slave of the contributing catalogues
- **immediate availability** of records
 - Scalability, no scheduling & batch maintenance
- interactive **feedback** – alignment, enrichment
 - Identifiers
 - Inter-record links – authorities,..
- Diagnostics – diffused **error resolution**
- **OAI & FTP**
 - Suited for batch loading
 - OAI is used where the data source exposes the metadata to be harvested for discovery purposes
 - Where the data source does not expect the data to be changed by the harvesting site or does not care
 - Hence one way – no mechanism for response or future synchronisation

CBS components
