What is open science?

Open science is the transformation and opening up of science, research and innovation through information and communication technologies.





European Commission policies

Member States: Council Conclusions on open science (May 2016)

- The Council:
 - O ACKNOWLEDGES that **open science has** the **potential** to increase the quality, impact and benefits of science and to accelerate advancement of knowledge by making it [...] better understandable by society and responsive to societal challenges [...]
 - AGREES to further promote the mainstreaming of open access to scientific publications by continuing to support a transition to immediate open access as the default by 2020
 - O "the underlying principle for the **optimal reuse of research data** should be: 'as open as possible, as closed as necessary'".
 - O Emphasises that optimal reuse can be realised if consistent with FAIR principles
 - Open Science Policy Platform (to promote further European Open Science Policy)

 - •Calls on the Commission, Member States and stakeholders to take necessary actions for making open science a reality



European Cloud Initiative (COM(2016)178)

- Problems addressed:
- Closed data; lack of re-use framework; lack of interoperability; fragmentation of infrastructure; lacking High Performance Computing (HPC)
- ECI pillars:
 - 1. European Open Science Cloud
 - Federated environment for cloud-based research and access to data
 - **○2. European Data Infrastructure**
 - Development and deployment of large-scale European HPC, data and network infrastructure
 - ○3. Widened user base (industry, e-gov, citizens)



The 2018 Recommendation on access to and preservation of scientific information (25.04.2018)

- New set of recommendations to support and guide Member States
- Reflects ongoing developments at EU level on EOSC and the increased capacity of data analytics
- A holistic approach regarding the transition to Open Science: Recommendation includes sections on rewards & incentives, skills & competencies, and asks Member States for action plans with concrete goals and objectives
- Highlights need for more developed infrastructure and integrated systems



Where does Cyprus stand?


- Adopted National Open Access Strategy (02/2016) – outcome of collaboration among a wide range of stakeholders
- RPF has included provisions in the "Restart 2016-2020" Programme
- Universities in the process of adopting OA/OS policies

OpenAIRE2020 Open Access Infrastructure for Research in Europe towards 2020



- Supports the H2020 vision of OA for publications & data (OpenAIRE as a central infrastructure and service for H2020)
- Monitors OA research outcomes from the EC and other national funders
- Provides a repository service to researchers with no access to an institutional repository <u>www.zenodo.org</u>
- Supports researchers in OA related issues through the National Open Access Desks Network (NOADs)- UCY NOAD-Cyprus http://www.openaire.eu/en/support/helpdesk
- Provides training (factsheets, webinars)


