

Laurels to Greece: Stylianos Kyria-kides's message to Athens last week was the same as that of Pheidippides, the first marathon runner, in 490 B.C.: "Rejoice, we conquer." The 35-year-old Athenian joined the great Greek marathoners on April 20 when he won the 50th Boston Marathon minutes ahead of the favorites Johnny Kelley and Gerry Cote. He ran the 26 miles 385 yards in 2:29.27.
