Athletic Equipment Fund Gets Net of Tuesday's Event

Whatever is left over from the expenses of conducting next Tuesday evening's special A. A. U. track and field meet at Randalls Island will go to the athletic equipment fund for Greece, according to an announcement yesterday. The meet starts at 6:30 P. M. and will pack a lot of action into one hour of competition.

The Greek fund started in the spring following an appeal by Stylianos Kyriakides, who won the Boston Marathon. Kyriakides cited the need for athletic equipment as one step toward the rehabilitation of his country's youth. Over \$700 has been raised so far and the hope is that a lot more will derive from the forthcoming streamlined meet. Tickets can be bought at A. A.
