10. To promote the Olympic Movement in the field of other sports.

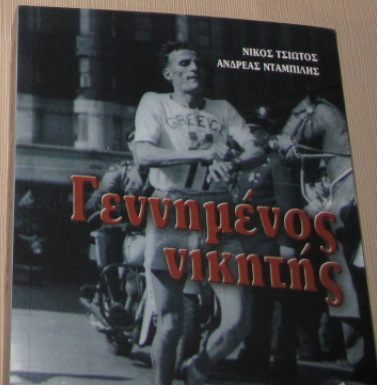
