I have the honour to submit my present application in the earnest hope that it will meet with your very ~~maxima~~ favourable consideration.

I solicit your assistance in helping me to join one of the Athletic Clubs under your jurisdiction, as my desire is to be able to come to England for this purpose and take part in all Olympic Games to be held in Great Britain and elsewhere.

I am a native of Cyprus and therefore a British Subject, and I am a runner of big distance races, and I took part in the Greek Championship held in Athens on the 27th & 28th May 1934 where I came first in the races of 5000 & 10000 metres.

Later on I participated in Balkan Championship at Zagreb (Jugoslavia) on the 26th August and 2nd September 1934 where I came first in the 10000 metres race and the famous Marathon race.

One month later I met in Athens the well known Hungarian Athletes in the long distance races and I defeated them in the big race of 30000 metres. (Marathon race)

My athletic career is not a long one, it started only lately and in a very short time I have become the Champion of long distance races, not only of Greece, but also of the Balkan peninsular and Hungary as it will be shown from the enclosed list of the events in which I participated with the respective dates and with my record

I beg to enclose also herewith letters of personal acquaintance and recommendations from the Honorable the Commissioner of Limassol and the President of the District Court of Limassol.

I am ready and willing to supply you with any other ~~maxxi~~ details and/or information or reference which you may require.

I hold also at your disposal my diplomas, certificates, etc. I shall be extremely obliged to you if you would be so kind as to let me know how it will be possible to me to join one of your Clubs and on which conditions I may be able to come to England to join same.
