The report upon this Watch when examined, is as follows:-

The trouble with the Silver C'graph Watch is that a new glass has been fitted much too flat, (present glass is not the one fitted when supplied.) The mainspring breaking, is due probably to overwinding because of the glass stopping Watch.

The Watch has been thoroughly tested, and we trust it will reach you in good order.
