Dear Sirs,

I wish at first to express my deepest regret on the demise of
His late Majesty King George the fifth.

I received your kind letter of the 11th December 1935, and thank
you very much for the information given therein in regard to the arrangements
to ~~xxx~~ be made in connection with the expense necessary for my participation
at the Olympic Games.

Soon after the receipt of your above letter, I approached the
Chief Commandant of Police, Mr. W. King, who promised to me that he will make
collections for me from the members of the English Community in Cyprus, so
that I may be ~~xxxxxxxx~~ enabled to proceed to London early in March in order
to be trained for the trials and try and be elected among the British Team.

As, however, the British Community in Cyprus are of opinion
that Great Britain may probably not take part at the Olympic Games, on account
of the death of His late Majesty King George, I should be much obliged and
thankful, if you would kindly let me know by cable whether Great Britain will
take part at the Olympic Games or not, and I shall expect to get an information
regarding the expense to be incurred by you in sending the above cable in
order to remit same. The said cable is absolutely necessary to me, as, in
the event that Great Britain will not participate at the Olympic Games,
no measures will be necessary to be taken from now for the collection for
me of the necessary amount enabling to proceed London for the trials.

Expecting to hear from you in due course and apologizing
for the trouble I am giving you in my case,
