Dear Stelios:

I received your letter and I was very happy to learn you are well.

Let me repeat here what I have already told you. It was an honor and a pleasure to have had you here as my guest while in Boston for the B A A Marathon Race. And if in the future you feel you can compete in the same race, knowing now as you do the condition of American roads and their requirements, you may feel free to write to me, and I shall try to help make it possible for you to make another try.

Under separate cover I am sending you a little package with three articles in it. Two of them are used by girls. One of these two is a little souvenir for your fiancée from me, and the other one is for Mr Mauricides' step-daughter. The third article is for Mr Mauricides' son. Please see that they get them. You can easily carry them in your pocket, I think.

Of the two which are for the girls, you select the one you like for your fiancée, and give the other to Mr Mauricides. The only difference between them is the shape, while in other respects they are the same.

I am also sending you best regards from all members of my family- brothers, sisters, nephews, nieces, etc. They all wish you a pleasant trip in which I also join.

I just wrote a letter to Mauricides telling him about you generally and about the three-class races down there, or a cup for 2:40 time if they do not agree. I told him you will explain things to him first, then you two go see or get together with the other members of the committee.
