The prizes awarded will be the following:

I/ To the Ist winner the Marathon Challenge Cup.
This Cup will be kept at the H.A.A.A. offices, the name of the winner being engraved on it. The winner will receive a miniature copy of the Cup.

2/ To the second winner the Cup of H.A.A.A.

3/ To the third winner the Cup "VRADINI". The above mentioned as well as the next three winners will receive winners medals and diplomas.

4/ Every runner who will terminate the course after the first six, and in the time of equal to, or less than two hous and fifty minutes (2.50 h.) will receive a disctinction medal and diploma.

5/ Every foreign participant who terminates the race and receives none of the above mentioned award, will receive a diploma of participation.

The Race will be held strictly under the rules and regulations of the I.A.A.F.

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE INTERNATIONAL CLASSICAL MARATHON RACE

The International Classical Marathon Race will be held every two years, the year before and after the Olympic Games. The first race is to be held on the second of October 1955.

The distance, is the official of 42.195 meters starting in the village of Marathon, running by the ancient "TYMBOS" (tomb of warriors who fell in the battle of Marathon), continuing on the asphalt road to Athens and ending in the Panathenean Stadium.

The participation is open to every amateur who will have the approval of his national governing body (according to the existing rules of the I.A.A.F.).

Entries must reach the Hellenic Amateur Athletic Association offices (4, Capsalis Street) on the 30th of August 1955, the latest.

All foreign participants will be the guests of the H.A.A.A. and the daily newspaper "VRADINI" during their stay in Athens (maximum eight days). The H.A.A.A. will undertake to secure maximum reductions on Greek railroads and steamers, if informed two months before the Race.

The H.A.A.A. and "VRADINI" invite the following runners to participate in the I.C.M.R., undertaking all their expenses, from the seat of their national governing body to Athens and back again.

- I/ The Three first winners in the Marathon Race of the European Championships held in 1954.
- 2/ The Winner of the British Championships Marathon Race of 1955.
- 3/ The best non Greek winner of the Balkan Games Marathon Race 1955.
