

In the spring of 1946, a young impoverished Greek came to Boston on a mission. He was here to run in and win the 50th Golden Anniversary Boston Marathon.

But Stylianos Kyriakides was not here to gain personal fame and fortune the way so many other runners have done in the years both before and since his miraculous marathon. Kyriakides was here to run for his country.


It was a mission borne of need, his need to help the homeland he loved. A country that had been devastated beyond words by the ravages of World War II.

His only hope in running that Boston Marathon was that he could raise awareness throughout the world, of the plight of his countrymen.
