2. ~~Inhave~~ Re. letters from our Embassy in Paris (dtd 23/9/81 & 16/10/81). (R 153-151 & R 155-154 respectively), the following action has been taken today:

(a) Mr Christofi, who informed me that the Deaf School also wishes to cash the *Opogona* mentioned in R. 153-151 was requested by me to ask the Deaf School to write to me accordingly;

(b) The M. of Ed. has already written, in respect of the Retarded children;

(c) I have requested Mr. Chu Ioannides, Director of the C.Red.t, to consult with Mr. Josephides & with Mr. A. Karagiorghis, (Deputy President & Treasurer, respectively) and to write to me what their recommendation is.

3. It appears that the *Opogona* mentioned in R. 153-151 are different from those mentioned in R. 155-154, and that the former are cashable, whereas the latter are not, since Mr. Stephanou wishes to keep a life interest therein.

4. After receipt of the letters at paras 1(a)&(c) I shall write to our Paris Embassy accordingly.
