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Research Libraries' role

- ✓ A multidisciplinary one stop-shop to support researchers in Open Science workflows
- ✓ Educators (Information literacy, use, access, manage sources etc)
- ✓ Open content providers (e.g. digitizing special or other collections)
- ✓ Institutional repository providers
- ✓ Important asset to policy makers for the creation, implementation and monitoring of policies



Research libraries readiness

- Established networks in all academia cycle and Information literacy experience
- ✓ Established Infrastructures
- Experience and a lot of knowledge gained through the years regarding several Open Science aspects (They are well aware of the challenges of OS)
- ✓ Libraries are well organised in networks (e.g. Consortia or Working Groups)
- ✓ They have strong connections (at least in EU level) and support each other
 - ✓ Organising webinars/workshops/conferences/training material (e.g. UNICA, LIBER etc)

University of Cyprus Library - "Stelios Ioannou" Learning Resource Centre (LRC)

- The Library established in 1992 and was relocated to its new building in **December 2018** (beg.2012).
- The largest library of Cyprus
 - Building 952 seats for studying and
 - Collection
- Open to Academia and public (573.000 visits in 2019-2020)
- Member of consortia and networks
- Collaborations with local governmental and private bodies - research and cultural institutions









Research Libraries challenges


- Lack or barriers of further investment
 - funding¹ on infrastructure or further education of librarians
 - under staffing in related expertise fields
- Allocation of specified/dedicated positions
 - Teams are needed to support the various aspects of OS
 - Rewarding mechanisms
- Training, training, training...
 - Legal issues
 - Citizen Science
 - Metrics & Rewards
 - FAIR Data/Data management
 - Technical aspects
 - Negotiation skills




How familiar are you with EOSC (European Open Science Cloud)?




In your opinion, what particular areas of training, support or advice, researchers and support staff need in relation to making data FAIR?

Open Science Taxonomy




















