

On July 10, 1878, in terms of the Anglo-Turkish Convention, in devising which, at the Berlin Conference, the diplomacy of Lord Beaconsfield played so important a part,

Cyprus was occupied by the British. In 1882 a constitution, with an elected council, was granted to the island.
