



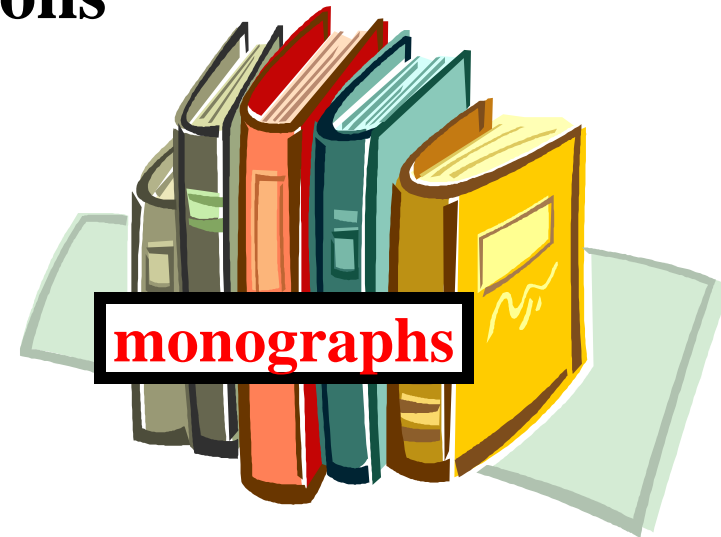

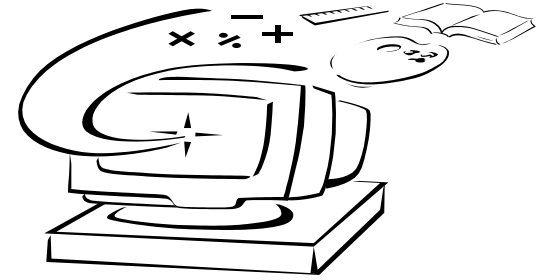


PCC, an international cooperative effort aimed at expanding global access to library collections



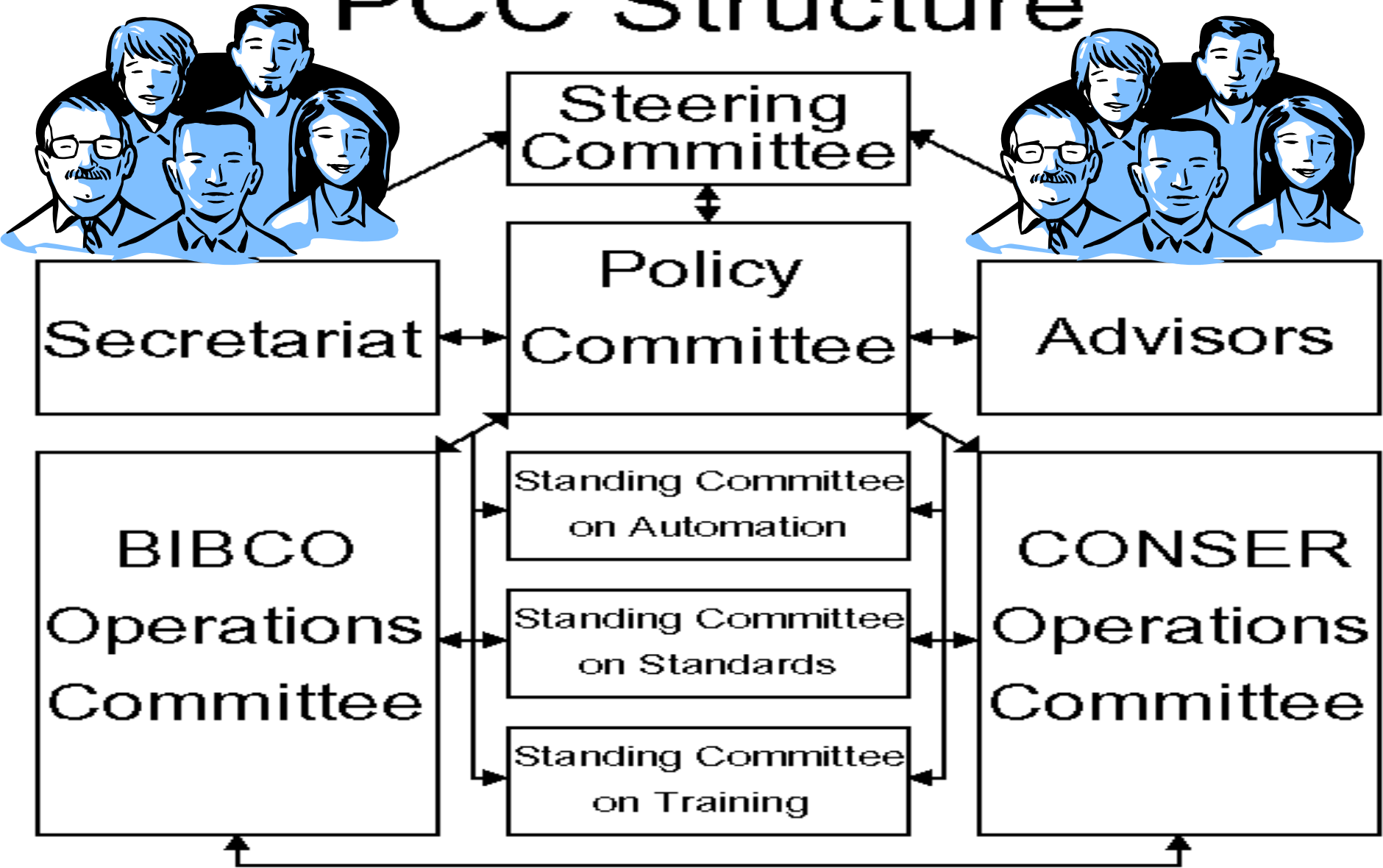


PCC HISTORY

- ★ **CONSER merged with PCC in 1997**

PCC Structure



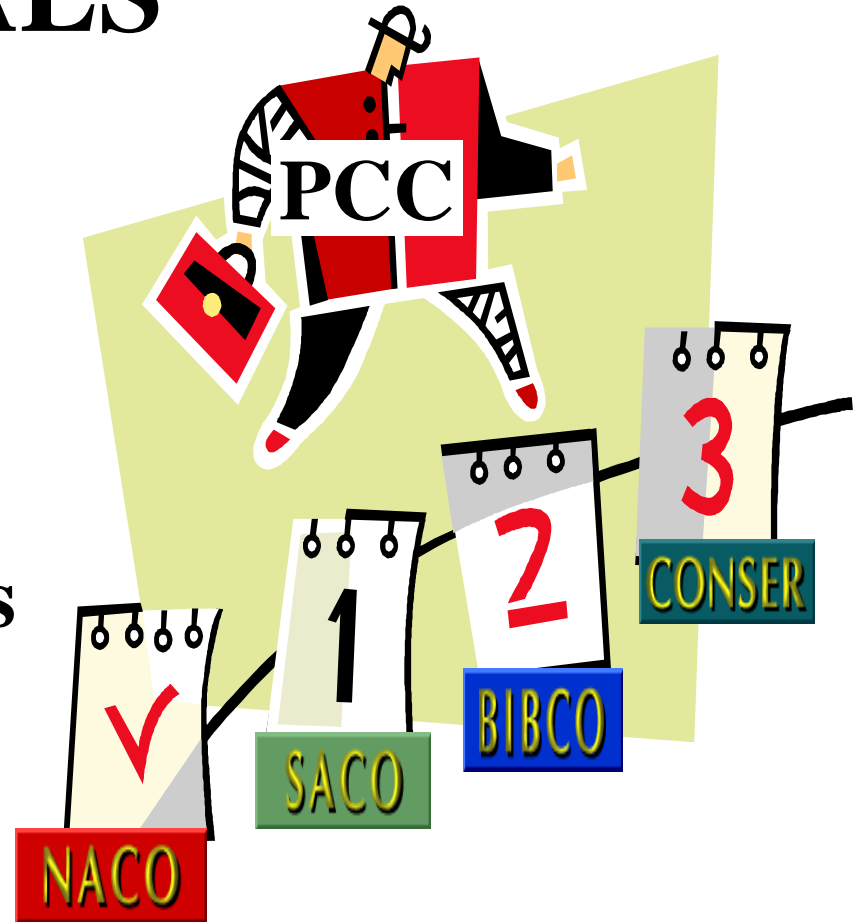
PCC VALUES

- 📖 **Create quality cataloging records, rich in content**

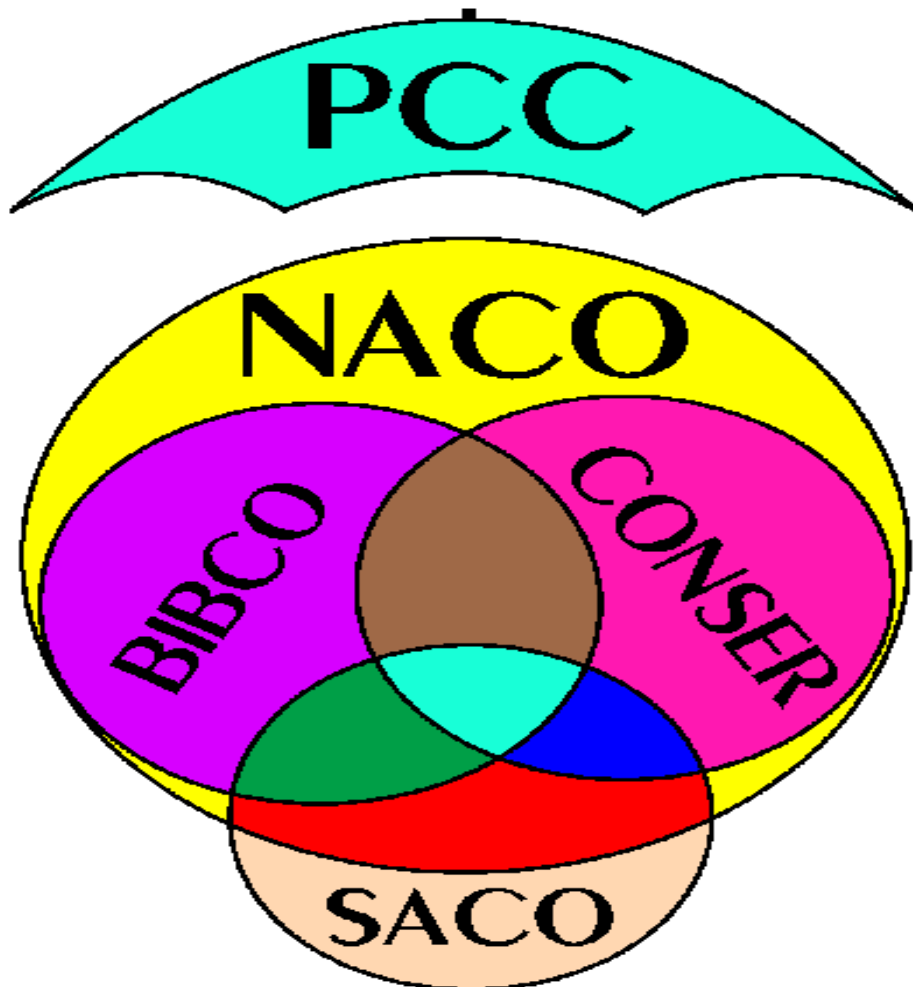

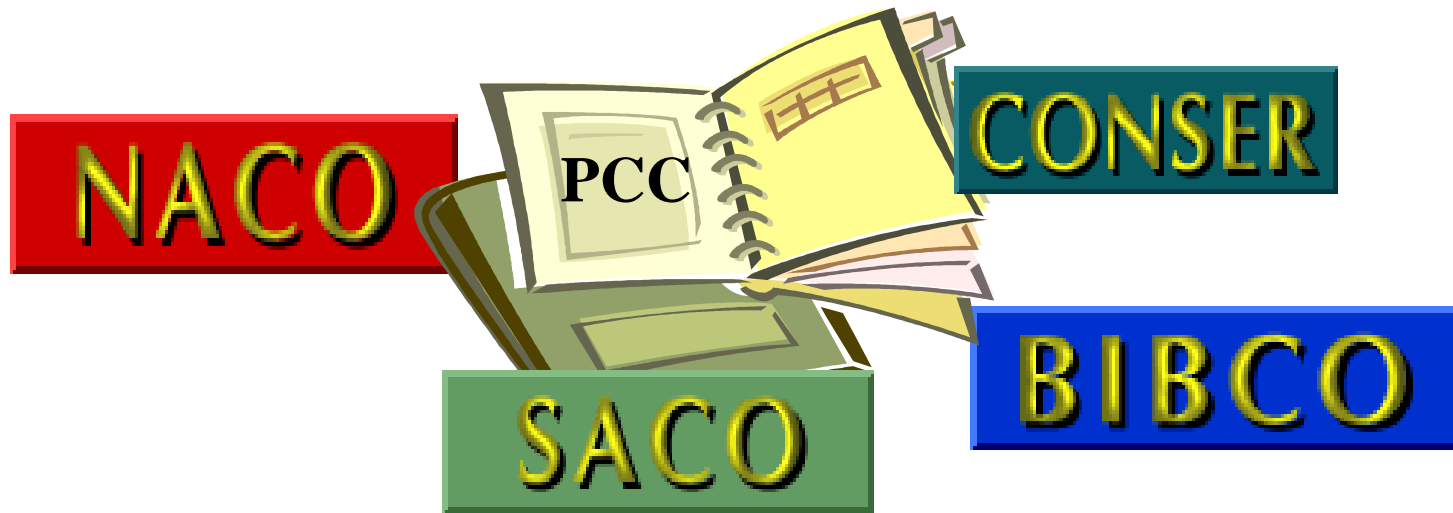

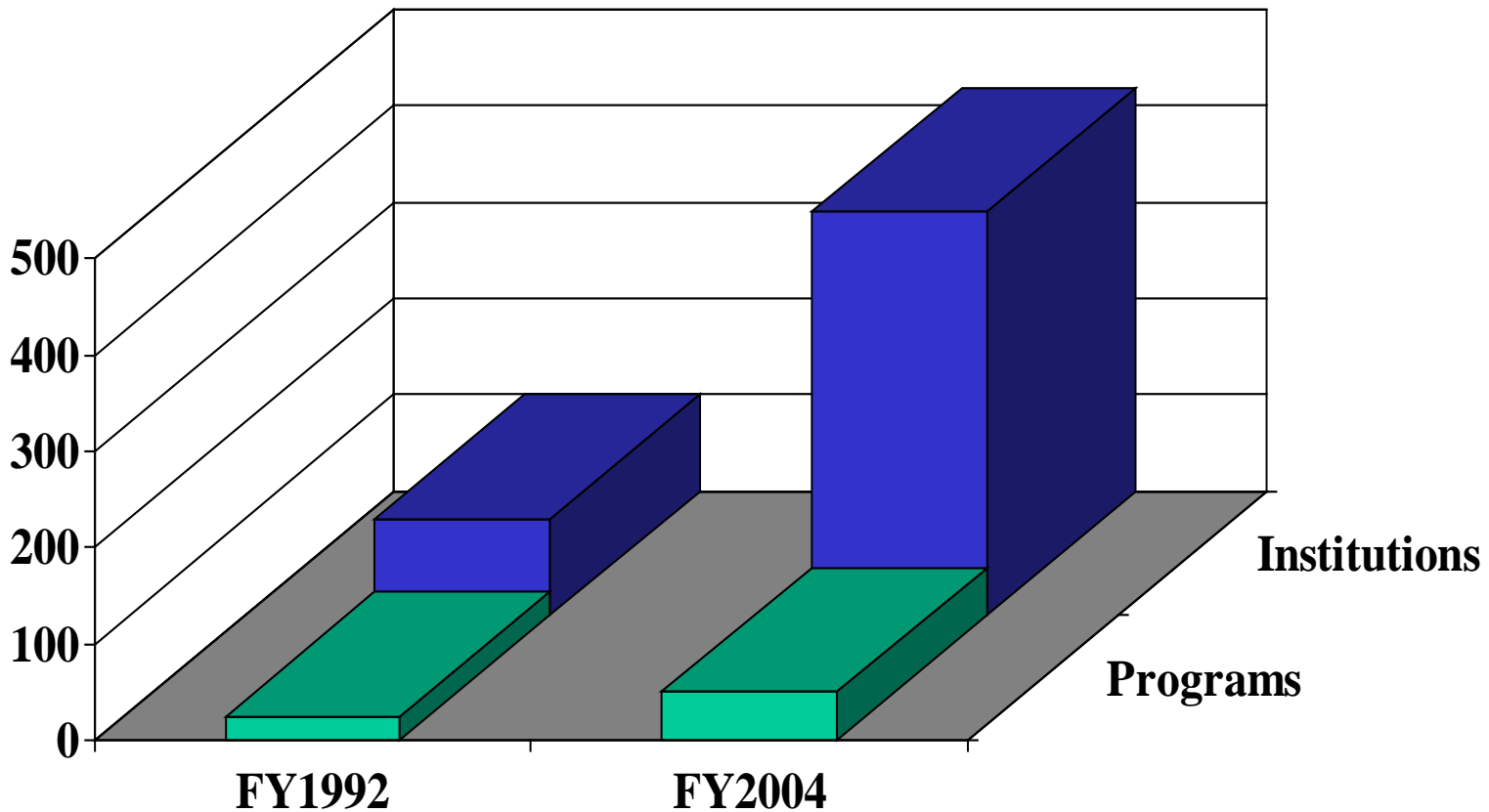
NACO program contributions

FY1992 – FY2004

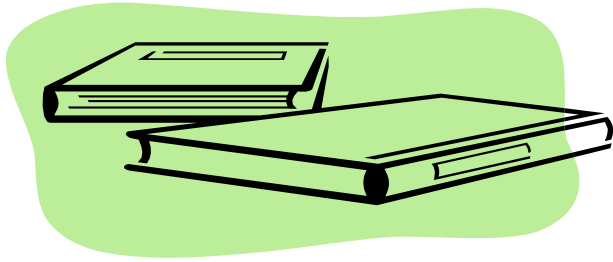

- **200 records per year--- large libraries (research libraries/academic libraries)**
- **Ability to exchange records via FTP (usually through membership in OCLC or RLG)**

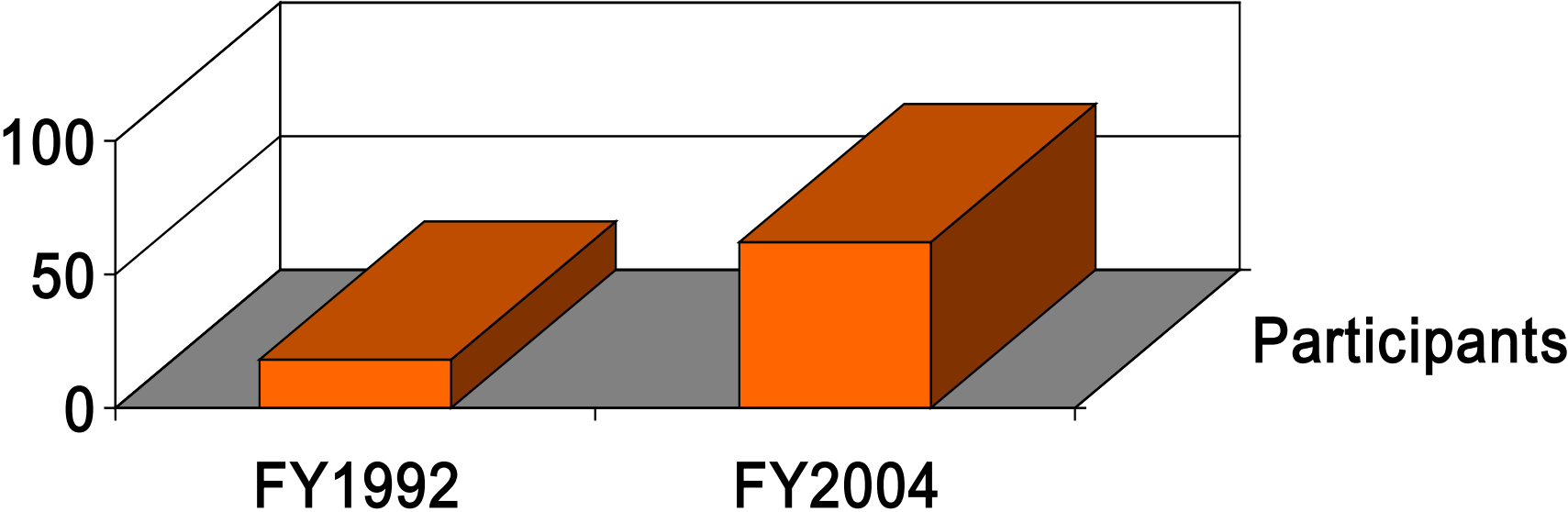

- **Mentors geographically diverse**

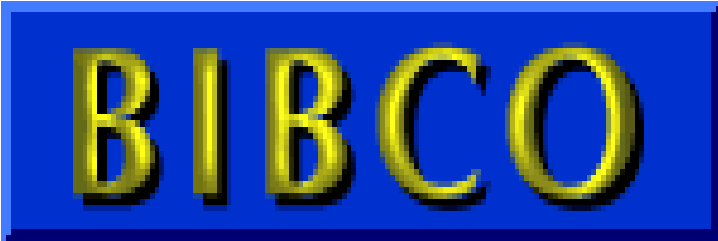

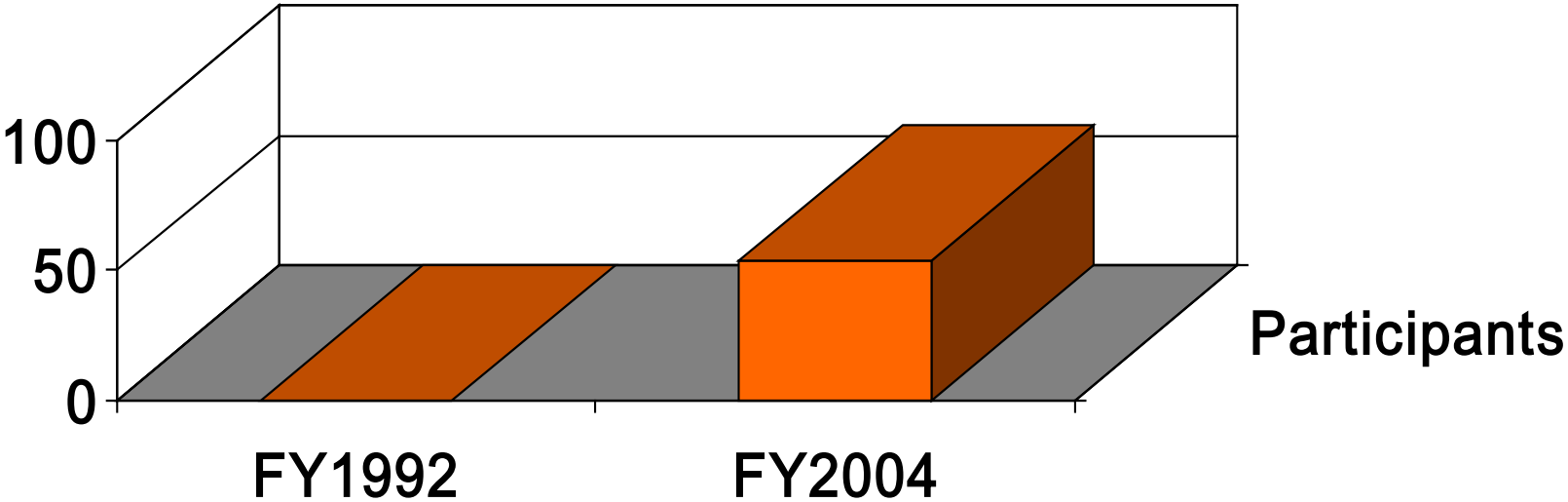

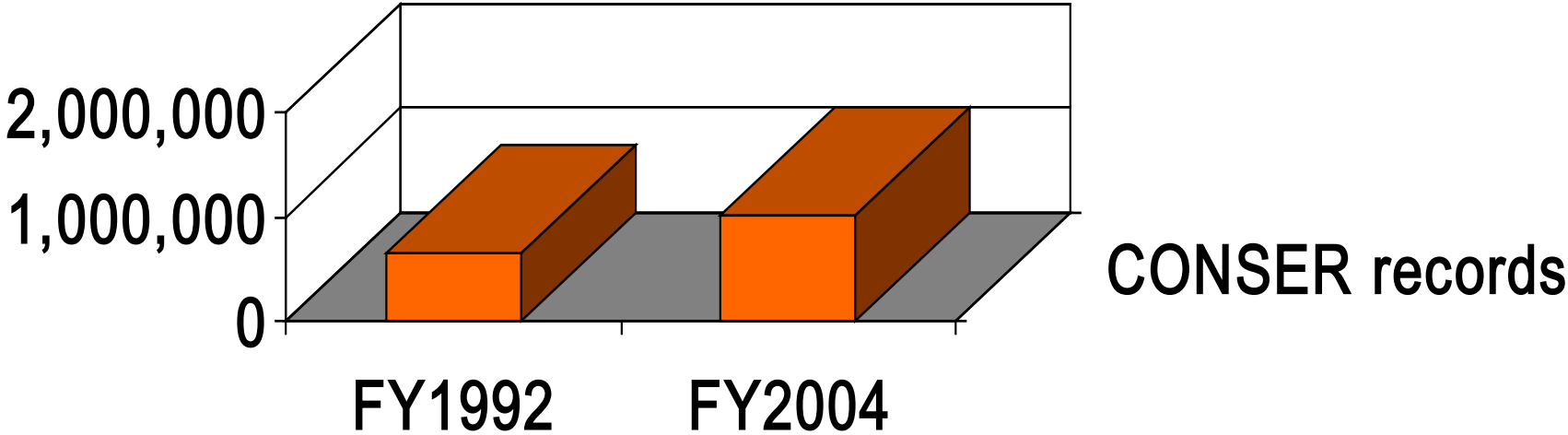

- **Address major issues relative to serials through study, international discussion, etc.**

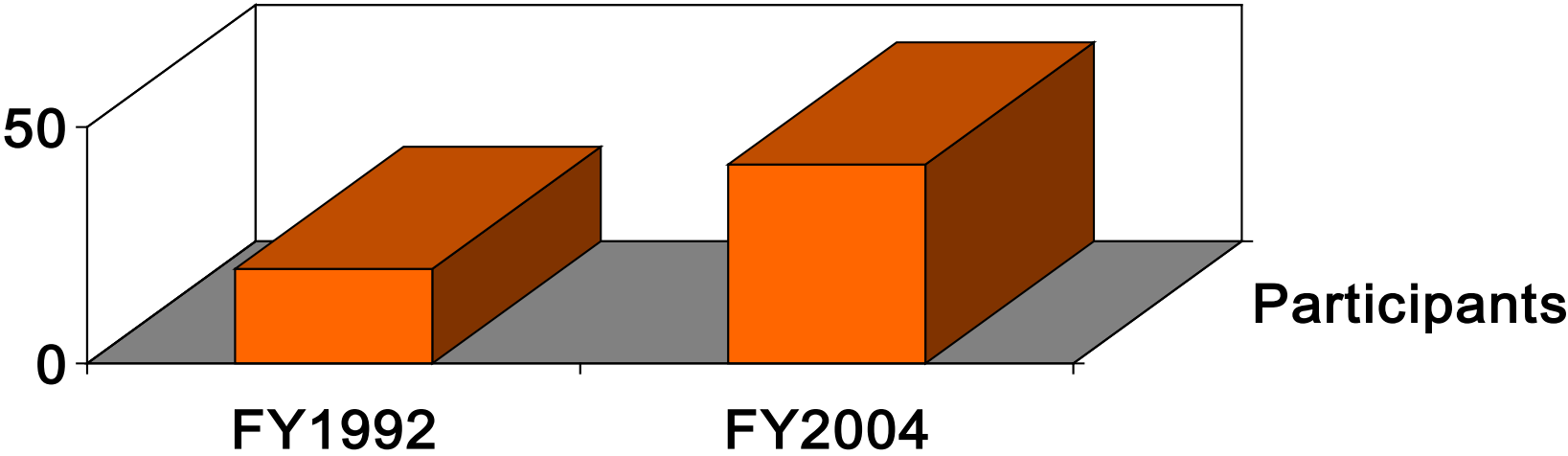

Program membership requirements:

- Independent NACO participation

- Full membership: Minimum of 400 transactions yearly (150 newly authenticated “bib” records (full or core level))

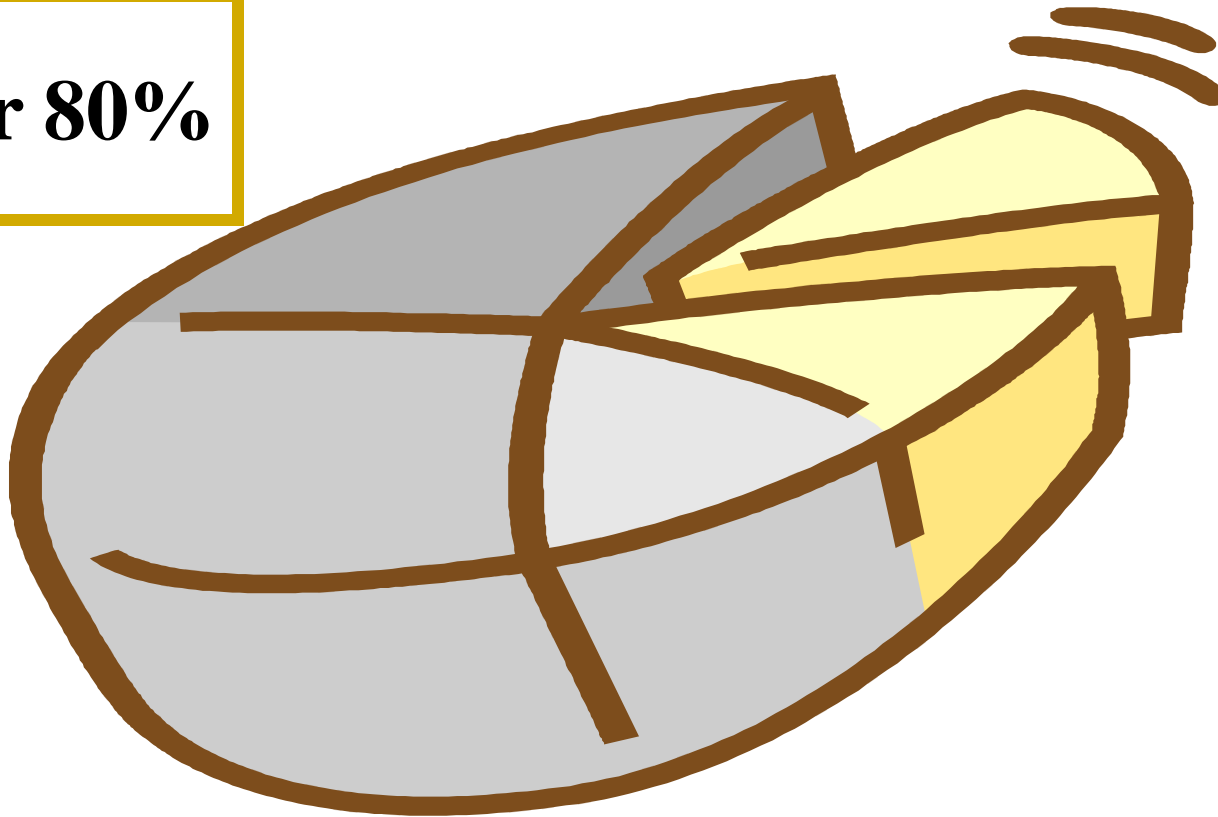

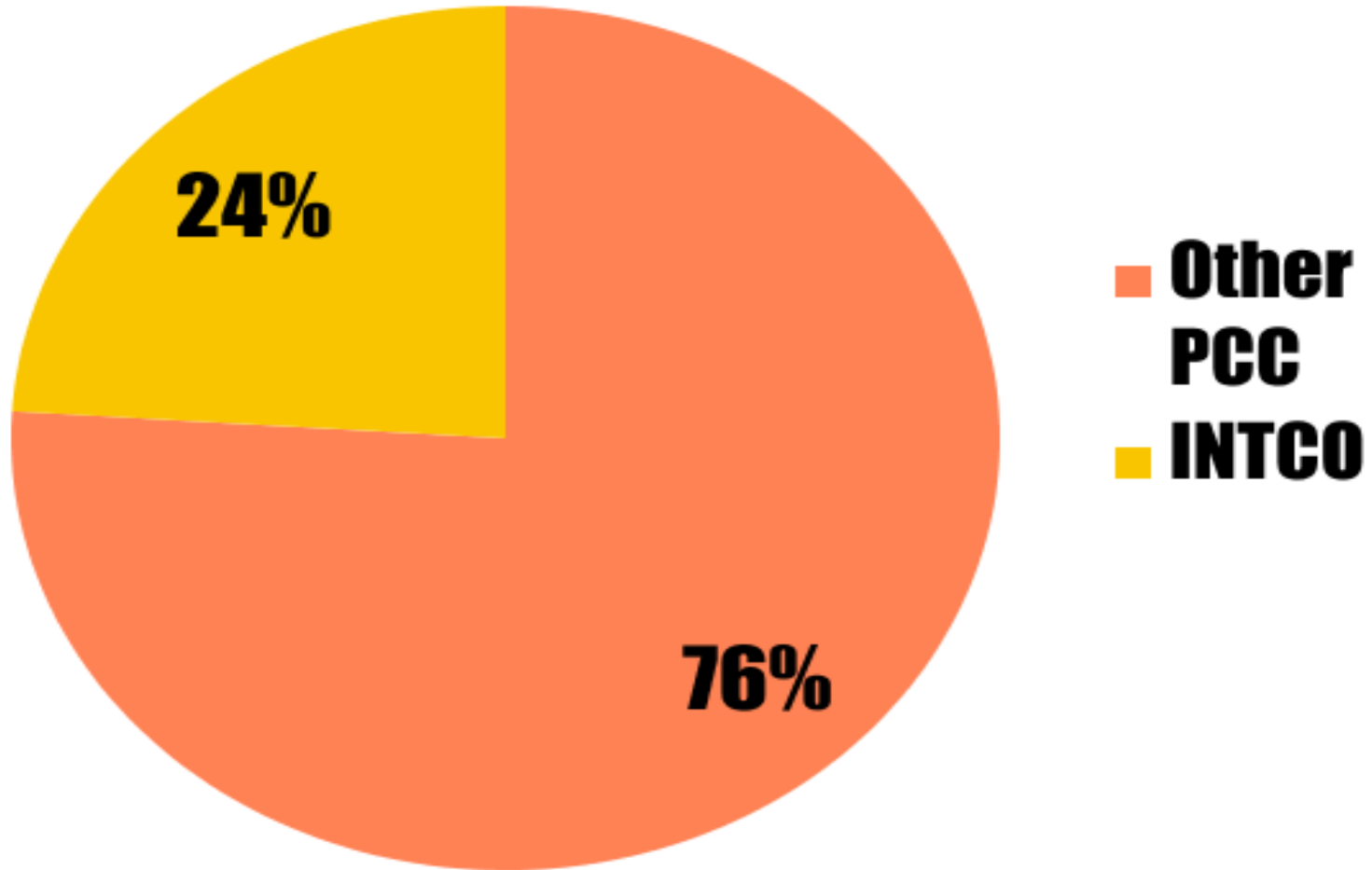
INTCO NARs FY04

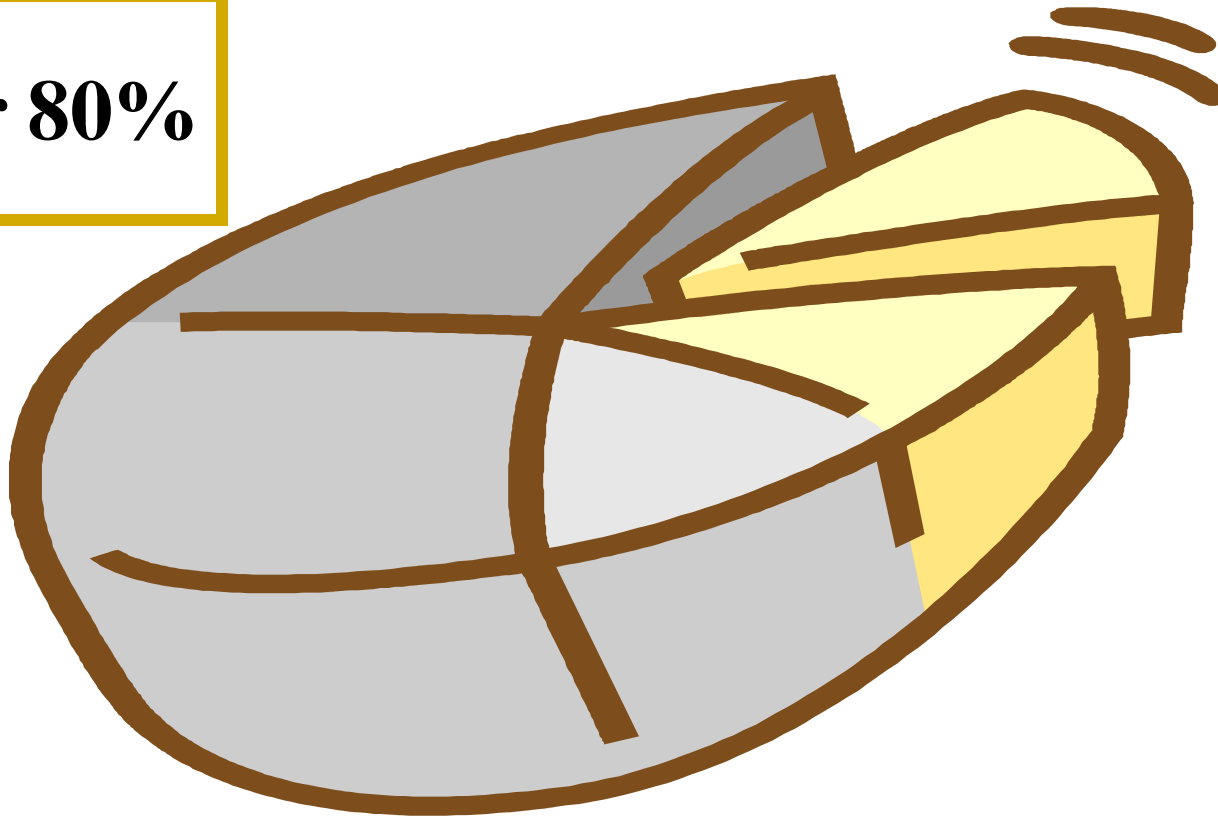

INTCO REVISED NARs FY04



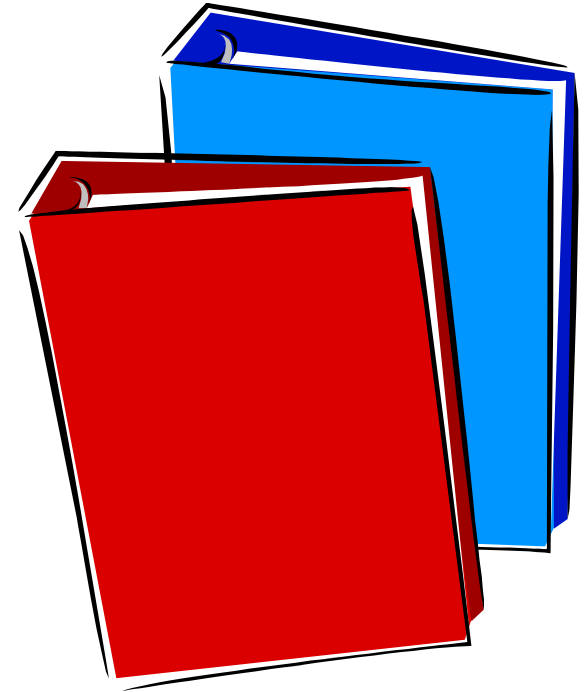
INTCO New Subjects FY04

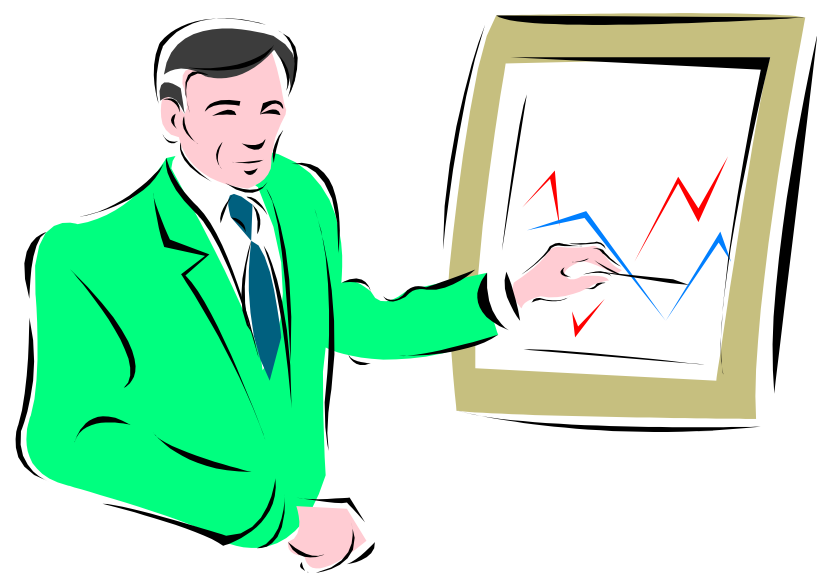

TRAINING:

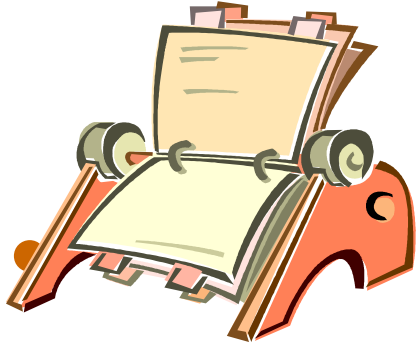
- 1. New participants are asked to attend a training class (usually 2-3 days) held at their own institution.**
