Το βιβλίο είναι αποτέλεσμα αφενός των είκοσι πέντε χρόνων ενεργού δραστηριοποίησης του συγγραφέα στο χώρο της επιστημονικής πληροφόρησης και των **βιβλιοθηκών** και αφετέρου της έρευνας που πραγματοποιήθηκε κατά τη διάρκεια της εκπόνησης της διδακτορικής διατριβής του, στο Τμήμα Αρχαιονομίας και Βιβλιοθηκονομίας του Ιονίου Πανεπιστημίου.

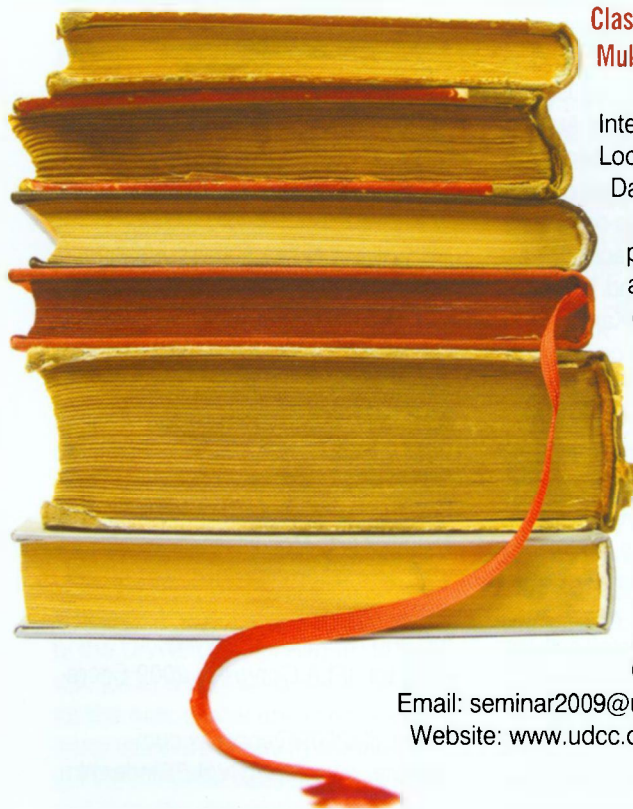
