Greek General Here Hits Soviet Aid to Satellites

Attacking Soviet Russia for her support of the former satellite nations of Bulgaria, Hungary and Romania, as well as Albania, which he described as a collaborating ally of the Axis during the war, Field Marshal Alexander Papagos last night appealed for justice for Greece, as he arrived for a three-day visit to Boston.

The general's attack on Russia came as the Boston Chapter, Greek-American Council, was completing plans to picket the Statler, Hotel tomorrow night when the local Ahepa organization fetes the man who led Greece during the Italian-German invasion. A spokesman for the group declared, "He is here to sell the royalist-Fascist regime he represents to the Greek-Americans."
