Track and Field

Kitel Son, Japanese youngster, won the classic marathon title in the new Olympic record time of 2 hours 29 minutes 19.2 seconds as the track and field competition closed. Johnny Kelley was the only American to finish. Ellison Brown and Bill McMahon dropped out.

America's 400-meter relay team of Jesse Owens, Ralph Metcalfe, Foy Draper and Frank Wykoff lowered the world record to 39.5 seconds, beating Italy and Germany. Great Britain won the 1,600-meter relay as the United States ran second.

In women's track and field, America won the 400-meter relay when the leading Germans dropped the baton and failed to finish. Ibolya Csak, Hungary, won the high jump with Annette Rogers, United States, tied for sixth. Kathryn Kelly and Alice Arden failed to land among the leaders.

Swimming

Ferenc Csik, Hungary, surprised the Japanese and the Americans by winning the 100-meter free style title. Peter Fick and Art Lindgren, Americans, finished sixth and seventh, respectively.

Katherine Rawls and Olive McKean qualified for the women's 100-meter free style final, but Rita Mastenbroek and Willy den Ouden, Netherlands, and Janet Campbell, Argentina, looked best in semi-finals. Masabata, Japan, and
