What I get now from the Municipality is £3-10-0 per month and it is impossible for me to live with this salary. The new budget of the Municipality is coming on shortly and if no end avour is made to include a proper pay for me, I shall work also during the current year with the same sallary. What I wanted from you is to take the trouble and write to Mr. Humfrey or to imaxk Mr.P.I. Kakoyianni to speak to the Mayor about the increase of my pay. These two gentlemen are friendly connected the Mayor of this town and I am sure that if they speak to him for this he will increase my pay without fail. I have no one else to see to my case and I attempt to ask you to endeavour for me and I imax shall be very greatful to you.

2. Please note that I shall write to A.A.A. secretary and ask him details about the Olympic sports to be held in Berlin in 1936 and after receiving his views I shall submit an application to him to include me in the list of those who will partake with the British Colours. Whatever reply I shall get from London, I shall submit it to you for perusal and for any remark or advice on your part. As I have observed you have taken a great interest in my case and I shall always consider you as my adviser and protector. I shall keep you awre of all my transactions in this connection and I hope you will vey kindly give me your advice and assistance in your power.

Hoping that you will excuse me for the trouble.
