The Association of Employees of the Athens Piraeus Electricity Company hereby wish to convey to you the heart-felt greetings of their members together with the expression of their feelings of friendship and closest fellowship.

The purpose of this letter is to put in to you an urgent appeal for assistance.

During a four-year enemy occupation of Greece the worker's income was practically completely wiped out as a result of the unprecedented inflation, and whatever items of clothing and footwear which he did not sell for subsistence purposes wore out.

In support of the present currency and economic stabilization effort, wages leave no margin for the purchase of clothing and footwear which, although obtainable locally, can only be purchased at extortionate prices out of the worker's reach.

Under the circumstances, we should feel extremely grateful if you would kindly assist us in providing footwear and clothing, both underwear and outer garments, to the members of this association.
