Japanese Rice:

General Rice, Japan, etc. The following are the principal varieties of rice grown in Japan, and their characteristics are given below. The varieties are classified according to the season of sowing, and the characteristics of the grain, the straw, and the yield.

The varieties are divided into two groups, early and late. The early varieties are sown in the spring and the late varieties are sown in the autumn. The early varieties are generally of the short-grained type, and the late varieties are generally of the long-grained type.

The characteristics of the grain, the straw, and the yield are given below for each variety.

1. *Katayuki* (Early): This variety is of the short-grained type, and is characterized by its high yield and early maturity. The grain is short and round, and the straw is short and brittle.
