Thank you for your letters.

2. With regard to a post in the Medical Dept. if a certain scheme is approved there will definitely be work for you under Aziz Eff., but for the time being I have nothing to offer. However, I will know within the next few weeks whether any scheme has been approved.

3. Would you please let me know in the meantime whether you would care if I submit your name either to the Collector of Customs or to the Commissioner of Police, for a post in one of these departments?

4. In your application you do not state whether you served in the Greek Army. I was informed before you arrived that you had actually been fighting in Albania. As you are aware, it is the policy of the Government to give ex-soldiers opportunities for work. Therefore, your case would be very much stronger if I was able to mention your army career.
