In the "Report of the Secretary General on his mission to Cyprus" of 19.11.1992 the UN Secretary General stated that the Greek Cypriot Side stated that it was in agreement with paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Set of Ideas. The Greek Cypriot side accepted the Set of Ideas and the UN map (territorial proposals) "as a basis for reaching an overall agreement" subject to amendments.

There are unfortunately no records of the meetings in New York of 12 to 23 June and 15 July to 11 August, but a summary is presented in Part 2 of the records. Part 3 consists of the records that follow.

On the 28.10.1992 the UNSG states that Mr. Denktash says that he accepts the principle of the UN proposals "in principle" that he reserves these rights.

Documents are mentioned in the records for October/November which are not on record, even though it is clear that the G/C side obtained them. Such documents include non-papers by the UNSG and Mr. Denktash's detailed comments on the Set of Ideas.

The Set of Ideas (Part 4) and the Non-Paper showing the UN, G/C and G/C positions (Part 5) are attached for ease of convenience.
