and more slender than the ventral hairs, which were
about 12 mm. long and covered with short hairs.
Horn base 12 mm. wide. (about 12 mm. long)
Width in middle 12 mm. (about 12 mm. long)
height (from junction) 12 mm. 2 mm. thick at base.
The tip of the horn is curved downwards.
Tip 12 mm. long and 12 mm. wide.
The horns are very slender and delicate.
Antlers: No antlers found in either sex.
