CONG: "PROVISIONAL REV. GOVT" IN S.V., AS NIXON CALLS FOR "RECIPROCITY"

Paris (Reuter - UPI) - The Viet Cong delegation to the Paris peace talks said yesterday that a provisional revolutionary government had been set up in a "liberated area" in South Vietnam.

Formation of the government was decided by representatives of the Front, the Alliance of National, Democratic and Peace forces and other "patriotic organizations," a spokesman at the Front's Press office said.

The Alliance, which aims its appeal at the middle classes, includes South Vietnam professional men and intellectuals.

The congress also decided to set up a consultative committee to advise the provisional government, the spokesman added.

Meanwhile, in Washington, President Nixon declared last night the United States and South Vietnam had "opened wide the door to peace" and called on North Vietnam to reciprocate.
