PROVISIONAL GOVT NOT TO AFFECT PARIS PEACE TALKS - U.S.

Paris (Reuter) - The formation of a Viet Cong sponsored "provisional revolutionary government" in South Vietnam should not affect the Paris peace talks, U.S. delegation sources here said yesterday.

In the first official American comment following Tuesday's announcement by the Viet Cong's National Liberation Front of the setting up of a provisional government in South Vietnam, the sources said that the United States delegation placed little significance in the manner in which the other side described itself.

The setting up of this government did not alter the realities of the political and military situation in South Vietnam. The problem of achieving a peaceful settlement remained, the sources said in answer to questions. -
